Instructions for Paper Presentations

1. Submit complete paper by 10th July 2019 at kslapma@gmail.com.
2. Students must prepare a 15-minute presentation.
3. The presentation format will be panels of five to six papers (15 minutes each) followed by 10 minutes of discussion.
4. Presentations must include research findings.
5. Students will submit final paper of not more than 3,500 words including the suggestions and feedback received within one month of the presentation. The final papers will be considered to be published in Kathmandu School of Law Review (ISSN 2091-2110) which is double blind peer reviewed journal published by the Kathmandu School of Law. The seminar proceedings will also be published online at the website of Kathmandu School of Law.
