Some Important Guidelines

1. All the researchers should collect the Supervisor Nomination Letter within a week from Research Department of College and should present it to the supervisor within one more week for preliminary contact from the day the notice is published.
2. Nominated supervisor can ask researcher to have minor changes or some required improvement on the proposal.
3. The researchers should frequently consult supervisor and at least should have 4 meetings held.
4. The researchers should fill-up the progress report on each section and get that signed by the supervisor.
5. Researchers are requested to go through the dissertation guideline and self-assessment form and prepare the dissertation accordingly.
6. Once the supervisor approves the dissertation, researcher should present a copy (along with Progress Report Form and Self-Assessment Checklist) for departmental approval before proceeding for the external evaluation.
