"CALL FOR RESEARCH PROPOSAL - 2021"

We are pleased to invite proposals from the students of B.A.LLB 3rd, 4th, 5th Year and LLM 1st and 2nd Year for 'Research Grants Program' initiated by the Research Department with the objective of increasing research strength of the institution and academic growth of law students. The research department has been entrusted to oversee the grants program under Assoc. Prof. Atindra Dahal.

A. Research Areas

The proposals shall be related to the themes as below -:

1. Constitutional Law/ Parliamentary Process/ Democracy
2. Criminal & Civil Law
3. Human Rights
4. Development and Environment
5. Society and Politics
6. International Law
7. International Humanitarian Law and Conflict Resolution
8. International Relations, Diplomacy and Security Studies
9. Business, Trade and Commerce

B. Award/Grant

An award of NRs. 30,000/- (**Thirty Thousand Rupees**) each shall be provided from the Award Fund Pool for Research to the applicants who are currently studying at Kathmandu School of Law and would like to start research project that are aligned with the above referred themes. Necessary tax shall be deducted as per the rules. Award recipients are expected to present their Research Article along with a report at Kathmandu School of Law by **June 30, 2021**.

C. Evaluation Criteria

Proposals will be evaluated according to the following criteria (100 points total):

- **10 points:** Project Description

- **25 points:** Significance and Rationale of project
- **25 points:** Research Questions: What questions are you asking and investigating?
- **15 points:** Research Design of the Study
- **25 points:** Quality of the written proposal, i.e., clarity, organization, and design (method, data, analysis)

D. Application Process

Eligible applicants and submission guidelines: The applicant should be full time students of Kathmandu School of Law, Nepal. Research Proposal should be in format provided along with this call.

Adjudication Process: Proposals will be reviewed by the committee of experts as formulated by the Research Department in time. The Award recipients will be notified by March 20, 2021.

Stipulations: Award recipients agree to

- sign a memorandum of understanding with KSL Research Department regarding the scope of work to be undertaken;
- submit a detailed research plan by **March 30,2021**.
- submit a progress report to the Research Department in **April 15, 2021**.
- submit the research report draft for evaluation by **May 10, 2021**.
- submit final research article by **May 30,2021**.
- present their finding along with report at Kathmandu School of Law in **June 30,2021**.
